Hard-wearing and durable, the turf is grown on Mansfield Sand's Fibresand which produces three dimensional strength and stability to a sand based rootzone with extremely rapid percolation rates.

Reinforced fibreturf provides a surface that is strong, load bearing, with dramatically reduced surface deformation and compaction from use and rapid percolation rates.

This turf is very tolerant of surface interaction with studded foot wear and so is ideal for football and rugby pitches. It is also suitable for car parks, pathways, emergency vehicle access routes, racecourses and other equestrian areas.

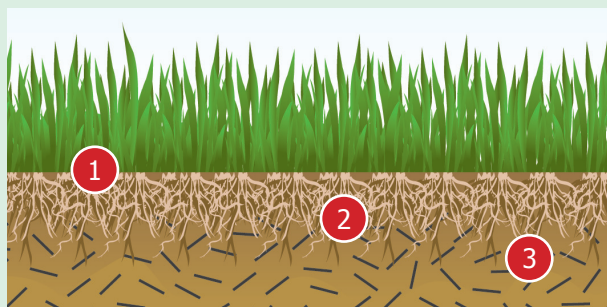

## Reinforced Fibreturf Technology - How it works

1. Sand gives the rootzone its necessary free draining characteristics so surface water drains away as quickly as possible
2. Organic matter provides the nutrient source to maintain healthy growth. It also provides a moisture buffer, important during dry spells
3. 35mm Polypropylene fibres give immediate, immense three dimensional strength and stability to the sand based rootzone. The fibres protect the natural turf roots and have a dramatic effect on reducing surface deformation and compaction from use.
